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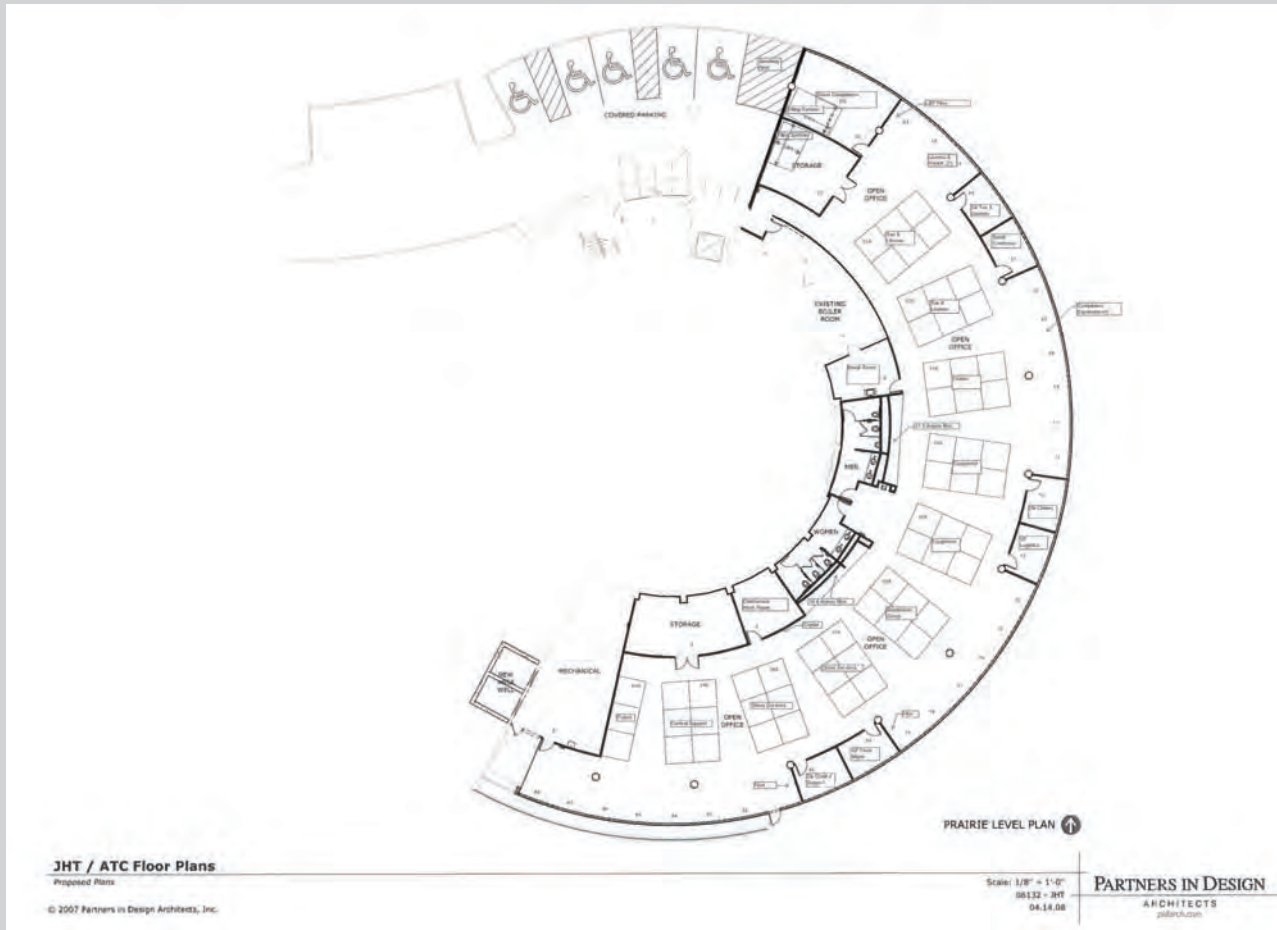
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Prairie Level Floor Plan (not to scale)

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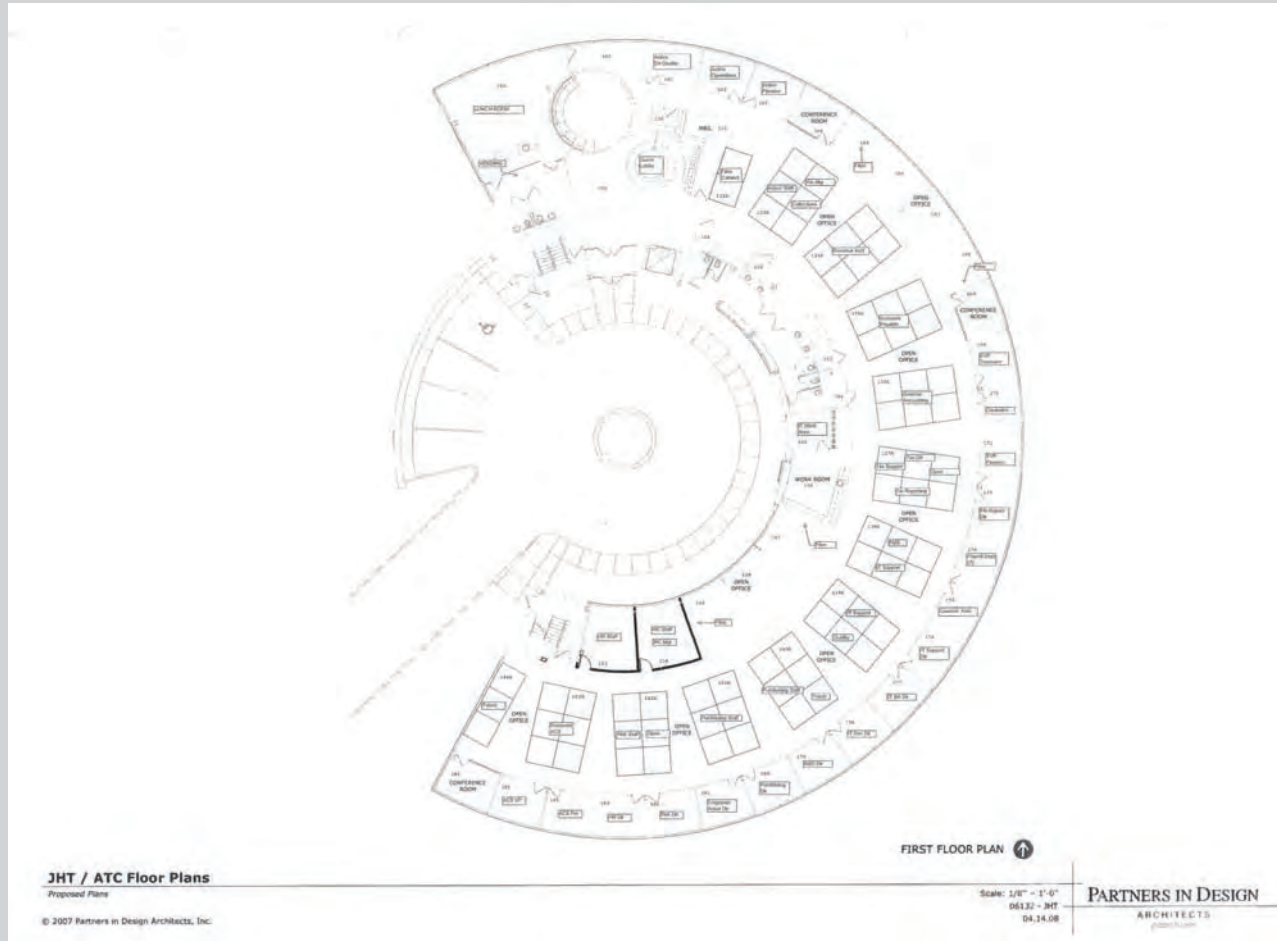

1st Floor - Floor Plan (not to scale)

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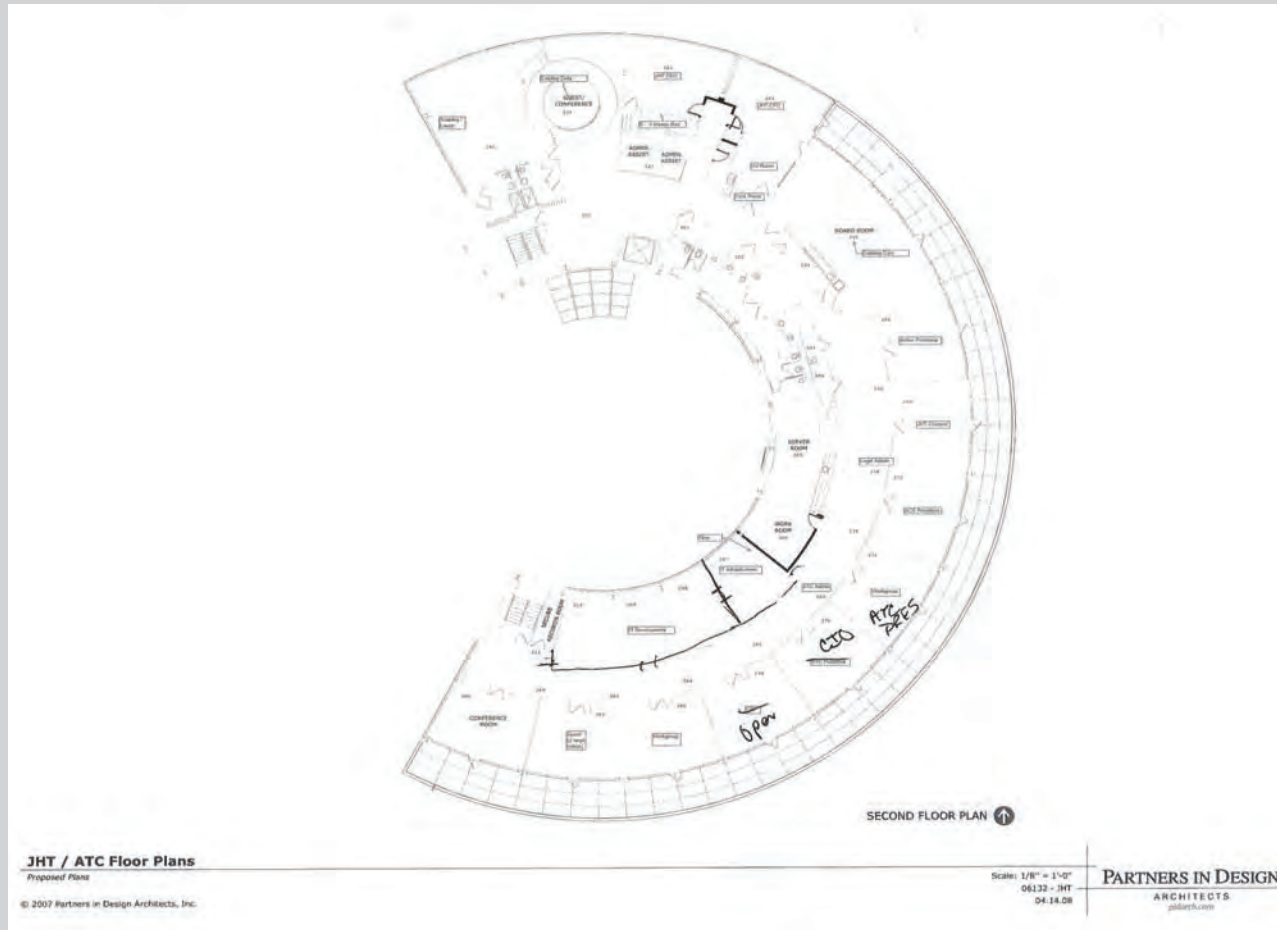
