WI DHS UPDATES

- Survey for the Health of Wisconsin (SHOW) is planning on conducing population based serological surveillance for COVID-19. Antibody testing will provide an opportunity to understand how the virus has spread through the Wisconsin population and identify locations with under-reported cases. The addition of a serological assay can validate exposures and help with moving forward in understanding important aspects of the prospects for herd immunity and risk of future infection from a SARS-CoV-2 like infection in the future. They will be sending invitations to past SHOW participants with hopes of recruiting up to 2000 past participants to provide blood samples. The surveillance will include a short blood draw and the blood will be sent directly to the WI state laboratory of hygiene for antibody testing. They are only conducting antibody testing at this time.
- CDC has updated isolation and quarantine guidance for the infectious period for asymptomatic individuals (again) to 2 days before and 10 days after specimen collection. The Contact Risk Assessment Flowchart has been updated on the PCA Portal as a result of this updated CDC Guidance.
